Topics in this Bulletin: Change in Emission Inspection Program Regulations

Effective July 1, 2016, the emissions program management fee (PMF), which is periodically reviewed, will be changing. The PMF will increase by \$0.18 to cover the OBD Equipment Specification Revisions and Program Enhancements. The updates are necessary to move to more modern sustainable equipment. The new fee will change from the current \$1.47 to \$1.65. Per Chapter 177.404 (Required certificates and station signs), you are required to update your signage to clearly indicate the new Program Management Fee.

A sample sign is included on the reverse side. Please update your current sign to reflect the new PMF, prior to the effective date.

Emissions Test and Exemption Fees

All test fees include the cost of labor for the inspection, but not the cost of parts, repairs and adjustments. No additional charge shall be made for one re-inspection, if necessary, within 30 days of the original inspection at this station.

All prices include a Program Management Fee (PMF) of \$1.65
