Testing Vehicles With Capless Fuel Filler Systems On New OBD/Visual Emission Equipment:

As a reminder, the new OBD/VISUAL emissions testing equipment includes the ability to capture whether or not a vehicle has a Capless Fuel Filler System. The new equipment software guides the inspector through a series of questions to collect all necessary data. To clarify how these questions should be answered, the following is being provided. (Note: The guidance below supersedes any and all previous instruction associated with LEGACY OBD/Visual equipment which has been completely discontinued.)

When testing a vehicle with a Capless Fuel Filler System on the new equipment, you will need to answer "Yes" to the first three questions of:

- 1. Is the vehicle Fuel Cap present?
- 2. Is the Fuel Cap Accessible? and
- 3. Can the Fuel Cap be Removed?

After collecting the required answers to the first three questions, the software asks, "Does the vehicle have a Capless Fuel Filler System?" Answer "Yes" to this question and the software appropriately bypasses the Adapter question and proceeds to the next testing phase.
