**Program Management Fee (PMF) Update:**

Effective January 1, 2026, the emissions program management fee (PMF), which is periodically reviewed, will be changing. The new fee will change from the current \$1.57 to \$1.80. Per Chapter 177.404 (Required certificates and station signs), you are required to update your signage to clearly indicate the new Program Management Fee. Please update your current sign to reflect the new PMF, prior to the effective date.
