**SUBJECT: EMISSIONS CERTIFICATION TRAINING**

Emissions Certification Training

As you may know, beginning in January 2004, Pennsylvania's Emissions Inspection and Maintenance (I/M) Program is scheduled to begin in the Northern Region, which consists of Blair, Cambria, Centre, Erie, Lackawanna, Luzerne, Lycoming and Mercer counties. The following implementation schedule for each county is planned:

Beginning January 2004	Erie and Mercer
Beginning February 2004	Blair, Cambria, and Centre
Beginning March 2004	Lackawanna, Luzerne, and Lycoming

Station owners who wish to participate in the upcoming emissions program need to have at least one certified emissions inspector employed at their station in order to be eligible for appointment as an Official Emissions Inspection Station.

Since the program is tailored to meet specific air quality needs, a special Emissions Inspector Certification course has been designed to enable technicians to perform only the required emissions Visual Anti-Tampering Check and Gas Cap Test.

The Emissions Inspector Certification course is a home study training program. This training program is available via a three to four hour web-based course or by obtaining a printed manual. If you select the web-based training, it can be accessed through [www.delphi-iss.com/paim](http://www.delphi-iss.com/paim). If you select the written manual, it can be purchased by calling the Aspire customer service toll free number at 1-800-247-1099, then pressing option 5.

Upon completion of the required training, a web-based final exam will be administered at Vo-techs and Community Colleges in the above listed counties. The user name and password (provided when registering for this training program) and a valid driver's license will be needed at the time of testing. Attached is a listing of testing facilities. As more facilities become available to offer the testing, the attached list will be
